Job Title: Interviewer

**Job Summary:** The interviewers lead people through the survey and help people answer the questions. Interviews will take place at the Qavvivik offices and in community locations. Interviewers will be given training and be supported by other members of the team.

## Responsibilities:

As an interviewer, you will be working with the Qavvivik staff and researchers from Université Laval to do the survey. To do so, you will be part of a team conducting the survey with Inuit participants. Your main responsibilities as an interviewer will be to:

- Participate in the training provided to the interviewers
- Assist participants in completing a questionnaire
- Follow research ethics and protocols
- Act as an ambassador of the Health Survey and Qavvivik

### **Qualification and Skills:**

- Able to communicate in Inuktitut
- Be punctual, reliable and motivated
- Open-minded, respectful and good with people
- Interest in health issues facing Inuit in the south.

# About Qavvivik and the QS Health Survey:

Qavvivik Inuit Family and Community Health Centre is an Inuit-run and Inuit-lead non-profit organization created in 2023. We serve all Inuit living in southern Québec. The Qanuikkat Siqinirmiut project is the first community-based study of the health of Inuit who live in Southern Quebec. The survey is a partnership between Université Laval and Qavvivik. The goal of the health survey is to better understand the health and wellbeing of Siqinirmiut. The data collected will be used to support the development of Inuit-specific health and social services for Inuit in southern Quebec. The survey data is owned and managed by Qavvivik in partnership with Inuit organizations and Laval University.

Salary and schedule: \$28-32/hr depending on experience. Minimum 24 hours per week.

**Starting:** March 26, 2024 for 4-6 months. Possibility of additional work with Qavvivik after the survey is completed.

Location: Qavvivik offices in Verdun and various places in the city where Inuit are present
